



Criteria

To qualify entrants must meet the following criteria:

- A current CAM member in good standing (one application per member firm)
- No fatalities, willful, or repeat MI/OSHA violations in the past three (3) years
- Days away from work, days of restricted work activity, and/or job transfer rate (DART) at or below 1.3 and Total Rate at or below 2.2. Calculate your number by going to <http://data.bls.gov/iirc/>
- Current Michigan Experience Modification Rating 1.0 or below

Application Process

Submit the following by March 15, 2026 (**late applications will not be accepted- no exceptions**):

- CAM Safety Achievement Award Application
- [MIOSHA 300A](#) worksheet "Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses Report"
- Your current Experience Modification Rating (EMR) calculation printed on your Workers' Compensation insurance company letterhead.

Winner Selection

Entrants will be broken down into the following categories by hours worked in Michigan:

- 0 to 50,999
- 51,000 to 199,999
- 200,000 to 499,999
- 500,000 and up

Winners will be determined by averaging the DART and the Total Recordable case rates. Entrants with the same average will then be ranked by EMR. Certificates will be awarded in three categories:

- 1) The top three companies in each hours worked category
- 2) The entrant with the lowest EMR
